ZANC SUNDAY SCHOOL CAMPING AT HIDDEN VILLA RANCH

This past fall (Sept, 26-28), several Sunday school families embarked on our 1st Annual Sunday School Camping Trip at Hidden Villa Ranch in Los Altos. A total of nine families (18 adults and 14 kids) came together to enjoy a fun-filled 3day/2night weekend in the wonderful outdoors. Reservations had been made many months in advance and maximum 40 people could be

accommodated as per restrictions of the venue.

This was a perfect location for the trip since it is conveniently located within a short driving distance, in the beautiful and serene Los Altos Hills. It is a working farmhouse with a huge modern kitchen, an adjoining dining/living room, shower/bathroom facilities & wood cabins with regular and bunk beds. There was also an outdoor fire pit and several long & short hiking/biking trails. It was a combination of rustic atmosphere with modern day amenities.



Of course, being a Parsi crowd, the eating arrangements had to be taken care of first!! © Each day two families were paired up for each of the 3 meals of the day – and every single person (including the kids) did their share of the cutting, cooking and the clean-up. There was a fantastic array of food from crepes, chocolate pancakes, ravo, akoori & rotlis for breakfast to pork curry/pasta for lunch to kheema and dhan dal for dinner. And of course, no parsi festivities are complete without the desserts (ice-creams with toppings), tea and liquor.

Between the eating sessions & the food frenzy, there were also many activities for the young and "not-so-young". There are several hiking trails on the property so every morning the group would take off for a strenuous hike for a few hours. Amazingly, there is no internet connection at the ranch (which is a blessing) so it was a great opportunity for the kids to bond outside of the Sunday school environment. They played board games & dominoes, showed off their musical skills at the piano, chatted endlessly with each other and best of all just "hung out" - running around, climbing trees, chasing each other etc. - this was the most endearing thing to see in this day and age! There was even a competitive cricket match between the adults and the kids (it is still debatable as to who won) ©. Of all the activities, however, the highlight of the trip had to be making s'mores by the fire pit in the beautiful outdoors. The adults had a gala time sitting out by the fireplace and the kids had a blast eating the yummy s'mores they made. After the day's activities tired out the younger generation, the "not-so-younger" generation got a chance to unwind and engage in their own "chit-chat" session till 4 am in the morning. The jokes and laughter was abundant with typical Parsi humor on this magical night.

RECIPE CORNER

Maleedo!:

(Contributed by Prochi Sethna, and enjoyed often by the ZANC community! Recipe is from the cook-book by Nergish Karanjia and Nergis Unwalla. Thanks!)

Ingredients

1/2 cup oil

1 cup cream of wheat

1/2 cup bisquick

1 tablespoon sugar

1 1/2 cups water

1 1/2 cups sugar

1 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1/2 teaspoon ground cardamom

1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg

1/4 cup almonds, blanched and slivered

1/4 cup raisins



Method:

In a pan heat the oil over low heat. Add cream of wheat and stir cook till mixture is golden brown. Add bisquick and continue stirring cook for 2 minutes. Remove from heat and set aside.

In a pot, brown 1 tablespoon of sugar till it is dark brown. Quickly add water and bring to a boil. Add sugar and all the flavorings to the water and boil till the sugar is completely dissolved (about 5 mins). Remove from heat, and add cream of wheat mixture stirring all the time to prevent lumps from forming. Cook over low heat till done. Empty into serving dish.

Sprinkle almonds and raisins. Serve warm.
