Handle all internal communications with members through issue of notices and bulletins.

Keep a membership book containing the names and addresses of members. In the case where membership has terminated, such fact will be recorded in the membership book together with the date of termination.

Exhibit at reasonable times the By-laws, the membership book and the minutes of the meetings. In general, perform all the duties incident to the office of the Secretary or which may be assigned to him/her from time to time by the Executive Committee.

The **Member-at-large** shall be assigned responsibilities in support of the objectives of ZANC.




Parsee General Hospital:
